Attention swing band members -- the Maryland Wing Swing Band has been requested once again for the CAP's National Board's annual Spaatz Awards dinner. This will be on the evening of March 6th [Saturday]. We do not know the precise time or location yet. Meantime, please hold March 6h open and let Major Carroll or Lieutenant Thompson know if you are available. This is an important CAP event, please try and make it.

Once again a reminder to Concert Band members that the Jewish War Veterans have requested our support a ceremony honoring Orde Wingate. This will be at Arlington National Cemetery, April 25th, 1400 - 1600. General Wingate was the leader of British special forces fighting the Japanese in Burma during WWII. He was killed [along with he entire aircrew] in the crash of an American military transport. They are buried in a common grave at Arlington. This will be the location of the ceremony. As a British officer in Palestine in the 1930's Wingate helped train Jewish self-defense forces that were the for-runners of today's Israeli military. We have been asked to accompany the JWV's cantor in performing the National Anthem. The choir of the British School in Washington will perform God Save the Queen and would like us to accompany them. We are also asked to accompany another groups of singers [as yet unidentified] in performing Hatikva [Israel's national anthem]. We do not have this one in our library. If anyone knows where we get can this, please let us know. We will also perform traditional military music appropriate to the occasion. Concert band members are requested to mark their calendars and let Major Carroll or Capt. Goolsby know if they are available for this event.
